Entries close at midnight on **Friday 5th April 2024** or sooner if the Meet reaches capacity.

PROMOTERS CONDITIONS

- 1 The competition will be swum under Swim England Laws and Regulations and Technical Rules of Racing and licensed by Swim England for entry into County and Regional Competitions.

 Any rules not covered by the Promoter's Conditions will be covered by the Swim England Laws on Open Competitions.
- 2 All competitors must be British Swimming registered at Club Compete and must be members of a club affiliated to Swim England, WASA or SASA.
- 3 Age groups are: 9, 10, 11, 12, 13, 14, and 15+ years in all events. Age as at 19th May 2024.
- 4 All events will be run on a heat declared winner (HDW) basis. Entries will be seeded into heats from submitted times, with the slowest heat first and the final heat spearheaded. Short course entry times should be submitted.
- 5 All entries are subject to meeting the qualifying times and will be accepted on a "first come first served basis". Entries will be rejected when the meet is full or from the last entry received if we cannot accept that entry in full.
- The Female category is for birth sex females in accordance with Swim England's Transgender and Non-Binary competition policy for swimming. By entering the 'Female' category, a swimmer confirms that their birth sex is female.
- 7 Entries will only be confirmed by email. It is the responsibility of the Club entering the swimmers to check for any inaccuracies in the confirmed entries. Any inaccuracies must be notified to the Meet Promoter prior to the Meet. Team managers will need to confirm any withdrawals, session by session, prior to the start of the warm-up for the relevant session. In the case of individual entries this is the responsibility of the swimmer.
- The Promoter reserves the right to refuse any entry. Incorrect or incomplete entries will not be accepted. Entries are accepted on the understanding that the competitor accepts the Promoter's Conditions.
- 9 No entries will be accepted after the closing date (including replacement entries on the day). Refunds will be given to Hy-Tek Meet Manager rejected entries, and not to invalid or incorrect entries. No refunds will be made to competitors who withdraw after advice of acceptance unless in extenuating circumstances and at the discretion of the promoter.
- 10 The success of any Open Meet relies heavily on the support of visiting clubs providing officials. All visiting clubs are asked to help by providing qualified and licensed officials for each session. Clubs will, however, not be rejected if they are unable to provide officials.

Officials can sign up to the meet through Swim Meet – Swim Meet. Officials who officiate at any of the Sessions will be entitled to Mileage Expenses at a Rate of 45p per mile from their home address to the Pool Venue and return, with a limit of one claim per day, regardless of the number of sessions attended in that day. Officials should request an Expenses Application Form from a Referee which should be completed and returned to that Referee during the duration of the Meet. Officials who officiate for two sessions in one day will be provided with lunch.

- 11 All events will be Heat Declared Winners (HDW) and awards will be made as detailed in point 3. Medals will be given to the top 3 swimmers in each event, in all age groups. Awards are to be collected from the Medals table when announced. All starts where possible and agreed with the referee will be over the top.
- 12 There will be trophies awarded to Top Open Swimmer and Top Girl Swimmer for all age groups in point 3, and Top Visiting Club based on points awarded for individual event performances within the QTs. Awards will be based on the acquisition of the highest points total throughout the meet (6 points for a 1st place, 5 for 2nd etc.). In the event of a tie, the number of first places etc will decide the winner. Awards will be presented to winners after the final event of the meet.
- 13 Para Swimmer Entries all swimmers must have an authorised SE/IPC swimming classification or Certificate of Exception or Certificate of Disability. In addition, details of disability, classification and exemptions must be provided with entry. It is the responsibility of each club to provide this information.
 - Please ensure the Certificate of Exception or Certificate of Disability are presented to the Referee prior to each competition session, failure to do so may result in disqualification.
- 14 A secondary strobe light will be available upon request, to be submitted at the time of entry.
- 15 The promoter conditions cannot be changed once Licenced. Only the Referee can make changes on the day to facilitate the smooth running of the meet.
- 16 Cub entries must be made electronically and submitted via email using the Hy-Tek software only. Please submit, via email, the summary sheet & Hy-Tek entries report print-out.
- 17 Individual entries may be made via email using the relevant entry form attached at the end of the pack. A copy of this form can be requested from southwoldmaymeet@gmail.com
- 18 For all entries, please supply an email address to enable the return of your acceptances / rejections and any other information as required.
- 19 All payments should be made via bank transfer details will be sent along with entry confirmation or on request from southwoldmaymeet@gmail.com Closing date for entries is midnight Friday 5th April 2024
- 20 Coach/team manager passes cost £10 per day, or £15 for the weekend, which will entitle the holder to admission to all sessions, a programme and start sheets. It is the responsibility of attending clubs to ensure that all Coaches and Chaperones have the appropriate Swim England registration and hold a valid Disclosures & Barring Service certificate (DBS clearance). Clubs must ensure passes are always worn by their representatives when on poolside.
- 21 Coaches / team managers are responsible for their swimmers at all times.
- 22 All meet participants and spectators must observe all safety precautions in operation at GL1 Leisure Centre and follow any instructions given by Leisure Centre staff.
- 23 A spectator charge will be payable for all adult spectators. Prices will be £5 per session or £8 for a day pass.
- 24 Competitors are advised not to leave their belongings unattended. Neither Southwold Swimming Club nor GL1 can accept responsibility for any property that may be lost, stolen or

damaged.

- With the submission of entries, consent is deemed to have been given, as required by the Data Protection Act 2018, to hold and distribute as necessary, any personal information on computer, to run the meet.
- 26 If the competition is oversubscribed the promoter reserves the right to close the competition to entries before the closing date.
- 27 Anyone wishing to use a device capable of photography or video recording must take careful note of the full Swim England Guidance on Photography that can be found in Wavepower the Swim England Child Safeguarding Policy and Procedures available at www.swimming.org Mobile phones must not be used, under any circumstances, in the changing areas this is in line with Wavepower guidelines.
- 28 The Promoter reserves the right to refuse admission to any competitor or spectator who shows aggressive or abusive behaviour towards any GL1 or Southwold Staff.
- 29 The Referee's decision is final subject to Swim England Law.
- 30 The event is to be held at *GL1 Leisure Centre, Bruton Way, Gloucester, GL1 1DT* a 25m, 8 lane pool.


